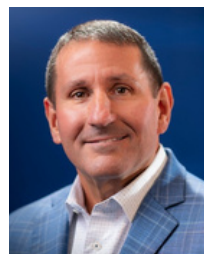

2024 Hope Ball Overview

In 2024, the Atlanta Hope Ball raised more than \$1.3M to fund our mission to improve the lives of cancer patients and their families.



2024 Hope Ball mission appeal brought energy unlike any year! The amazing guests and donors raised over \$400,000 for the Atlanta Hope Lodge.



In 2024, the Atlanta Hope Lodge provided 30,692 nights of free lodging, served 1,211 guests, and provided 5,123 rides to cancer patients and caregivers.



The American Cancer Society has funded 53 investigators who went on to win the Nobel Prize, considered the highest accolade any scientist can receive.



In the United States, 1 in 2 men and 1 in 3 women will be diagnosed with cancer in their lifetime. Thanks to our work together, there is a 33% decline in cancer deaths.

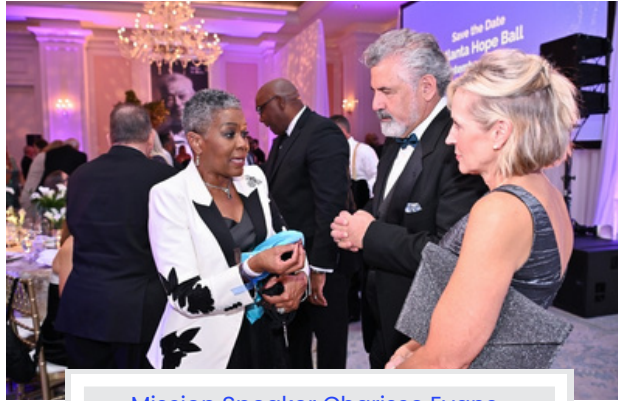

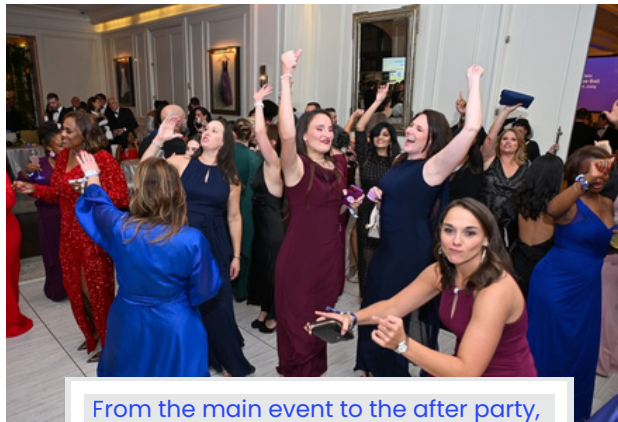

THE HOPE LODGE

Facing cancer is hard. Having to travel out of town for treatment can make it even harder. Our Hope Lodge® communities provide free, temporary lodging for people facing cancer and their caregivers when treatment is far from home.

Each year, approximately 200,000 cancer patients must travel 40+ miles to treatment. American Cancer Society Hope Lodge® helps people with cancer be close to vital treatment when they need it most. Hope Lodge communities also support over 225 referring hospitals, as well as the local economies in more than 30 locations.

The Atlanta Hope Ball Mission Moment Impact

\$2,940	Provides lodging during a 6-week radiation treatment
\$6,300	Provides lodging for 90 nights for a bone marrow transplant recipient
\$10,000	20 weeks of free lodging for a patient or a 6-week stay for 3 patients
\$25,000	Free lodging grants for 325 nights or free lodging grants for 45 patients

These funds allow us to continue our life-saving support programs and research right here in Georgia

Provided **2,465** rides to treatment in Georgia through the Road to Recovery program.

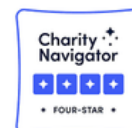
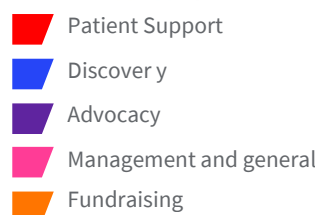
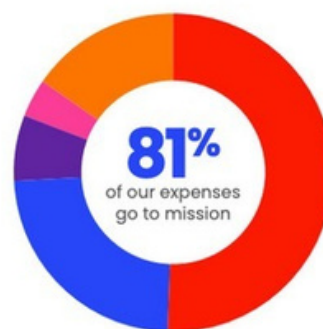
