Meaningful Impact

In 2025, the Atlanta Hope Ball raised roughly \$1.47 million to boldly advance our mission to improve the lives of cancer patients and their families.



The 2025 Hope Ball mission appeal soared past last year's momentum! The amazing guests and donors raised over \$480,000 for the Atlanta Hope Lodge.



In 2025, the Atlanta Hope Lodge has already provided 27,608 nights of free lodging to 983 guests and 3,594 rides for cancer patients and caregivers - saving families more than \$3.68 million in expenses.



The American Cancer Society has funded 53 investigators who went on to win the Nobel Prize, considered the highest accolade any scientist can receive.



In the United States, 1 in 2 men and 1 in 3 women will be diagnosed with cancer in their lifetime. Thanks to our work together, the cancer death rate has dropped by 34%, saving more than 4.5 million lives.





The American Cancer Society Hope Lodge® in Atlanta, opened in 1998, is a home away from home for people with cancer and their caretakers while going through treatment or a clinical trial. The facility offers 57 guest rooms, fully equipped community kitchens for food storage and preparation, gathering areas and community dining rooms, laundry rooms stocked with supplies, and outdoor reflection or meditation spaces, all located near treatment centers in the area.

The Hope Lodge is a loving, caring place for people in need of help, company, and companionship. I met so many wonderful people in my same situation, and that makes the time and treatments bearable. It is like coming home every day to friends.
